During the meeting, the partners worked together to design the Model for developing knowledge on patient safety, intercultural communication skills and capacity of working in multidisciplinary/multicultural team.

A number of 120 participants from five European countries were involved in the study. All participants stated the importance of intercultural communication skills and knowledge and how they are integrated into the daily work of members of MMHTs to provide safe patient care.

Output 2- European model for developing intercultural communication skills and capacity of working in MMHT's.

A workshop was conducted By Professor Irena Papadopoulou with a number of presentations and explorations of various approaches documented in the literature as well as the two approaches which originate at Middlesex University (ENABLE, and the MOOC learning approach for the culturally competent compassion MOOC).

The Massive Open Online Course (MOOC)

The course will be six weeks long.

Week 1- Orientation: familiarisation with the MOOC, pre-MOOC questionnaire;

Weeks 2, 3 and 4 -Learning activities on the Modules;

Week 5 -Synthesis: participants will work in groups to co-create tools such as animations, videos, vimeos, wikis etc. and two webinars will be also organised;

Week 6 - Assessment: summative assessment assignment ("My MOOC journey"), post-MOOC questionnaire and course evaluation questionnaire.
